

Putting Out a Cooking Fire

1. Turn the stove or oven off immediately!
2. Use a fire extinguisher to put out a fire.
 - ◆ If you do not have a fire extinguisher, cover the pan with a lid or other non-flammable object to suffocate the fire.
 - ◆ If covering the pan is not possible, pour salt or baking soda on the fire.
3. If the fire does not go out immediately, call the fire department.



Important!

Don't throw water on grease fires.

Be Aware!

The BEST way to put out a fire is with a fire extinguisher. Many buildings, such as apartment buildings, must have fire extinguishers in the hall or other areas close to each unit.
